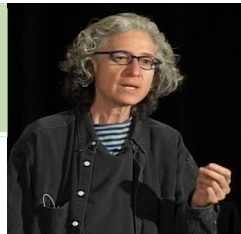


Introduction and Adoptive Parents Panel:
